## Tzelan



At the helm of recently launched New York-based luxury lifestyle brand Tzelan is Alison Chi, the daughter of respected hospitality designer Tony Chi. The name Tzelan is derived from the Chinese word *zhiban*, which loosely describes a moment of bliss — just what the Ongo lamp (left) provides. Initiated by *tonychi* and associates searching for an alternative light source, the Ongo is the result of a collaboration between Tzelan and Italian lighting manufacturer Contardi, and features LED technology in a portable design with the option of nine luxurious finishes.

## Promemoria

Luxury Italian furniture brand Promemoria has teamed up once again with London-based David Collins Studio to create The London Collection. Building on their Capsule Collection launched two years ago at the Milan Salone, the new collection — over two years in the making — consists of 16 pieces from furniture to lighting. Each piece has been named for one of the city's garden squares, so beloved by the late designer, and made with the utmost attention to detail, craftsmanship and materials. The Bramham chair (right) is a lower, loungier version of the original, and this time is offered in a variety of luxe colour lacquer finishes and available with a removable back cushion in leather.
